with our "Energy Conservation Stewardship" Award. United Parish was recently awarded an Energy Star for Congregations Award (a program of the Environmental Protection Agency) for its recent implementation of energy-efficient improvements. Among its improvements, United Parish upgraded the insulation in the attic and walls of the church, installed new energy-efficient windows, and rebuilt the entry doors. United Parish also upgraded its lighting, installing compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs), T-8 fluorescent lamps, high-pressure sodium lamps, and light-emitting diode (LED) exit signs. Significantly, the parish converted its heating system from oil to (cleaner burning) natural gas. United Parish is preventing about 26,000 pounds of CO2 per year from entering the atmosphere – all while saving money on utility bills. Thank you for setting a powerful example of environmental stewardship for the community of faith.
