with our “Do Well by Doing Good” Award. In November 2002, the church’s original boiler (vintage 1969, 67% efficiency rating) stopped working, leaving two inches of water on the floor. This created a crisis for both the church at the Striar Jewish day care center housed there. Trinity Church’s senior warden contacted MIP&L and worked to get utility rebates (as well as a Stokes Loan from the Episcopal Diocese of Massachusetts) to put in a new boiler. This new boiler is 93% efficient, with improved zoning and control systems. The new boiler will reduce harmful emissions from the facility and save the congregation approximately \$33,700 in heating bills over 20 years. Thank you for setting a powerful example of environmental stewardship for the community of faith.
